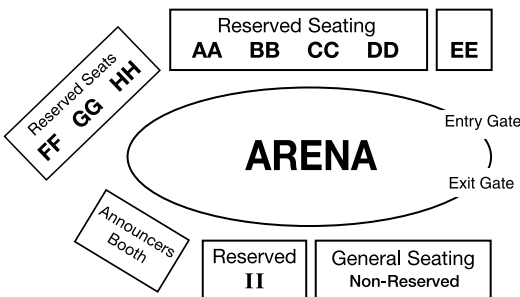

How to Order Tickets

Performance Tickets are available as follows: Beginning May 1 we will accept mail & fax orders. Phone & walk-in orders will be accepted beginning June 1. **We encourage our patrons to take advantage of the early mail or fax option which will give you the best available seating.** Just fill out the form on the previous page and mail or fax it. Downloadable ticket order forms are available at www.NevadaCountyFair.com. NOTE: Written requests for "call when order is processed" will be considered a phone order and will not be filled until June 1. **Tickets purchased after Wednesday, September 22 are an additional \$3.**

REFUNDS & EXCHANGES

We realize that circumstances may be such that require exchanges or cancellations of tickets. In an attempt to meet these needs, we will impose a \$3 per ticket charge to cover administrative costs for either returns or exchanges for individual performance tickets and \$10 for each season ticket package. No refunds or exchanges will be made within 10 days of opening night of the Draft Horse Classic.

ARENA & WEATHER

As a reminder, the Nevada County Fairground's arena is open air and we do not guarantee shade for ANY performance. Please consider an evening performance if this is a concern for you. Weather can be variable during this event. Generally we have warm (to hot) sunny days and cool evenings. Please plan accordingly with hats or sunscreen. Sweaters or jackets are recommended for evening performances.

PLEASE NOTE: All performances are rain or shine.

RV Camping at the Classic

RV Camping at the Draft Horse Classic is limited to ticket holders. All water & electric sites require a four-night minimum stay between Wednesday, September 22nd and Sunday, September 26th and are assigned on a first come/first served basis by date of reservation. If you want to reserve several sites together, they must all be included on the same order form with each rigs' size and type. (Limited group sites are available.)

Water & electric sites are \$30/night.

Dry camping is available for \$20/night with no minimum stay requirement. Site assignment is done at the time of arrival.

RV Camping includes one parking pass per rig. If you have additional vehicles joining you, please purchase additional parking passes (available on the ticket order form.)

If you request a water & electric site and there are no available sites, we will issue you a refund (or adjust your credit card charge amount) for the difference between the water & electric site camping fee and the dry camping fee.

*During large festivals, we do not guarantee specific amperage amounts in water & electric sites — bring amperage adaptors and water splitters.
